May 2ND 2025. The Council of Heritage Motor Clubs NSW Inc. is pleased to announce that Lachlan Holgate, a 15-year-old student from Wagga Wagga, is the recipient of the 2025 CHMC Youth Award Grant for his restoration project, a 1953 Willys Jeep CJ3B. Lachlan was nominated by the Wagga Wagga Veteran & Vintage Motor Club.

The Award judging panel were impressed with Lachlan's enthusiasm for restoration and his commitment to the historic vehicle community. His Award includes a grant of \$1500 to assist in acquiring parts needed for his Jeep's restoration.

"I am truly honoured to receive this recognition," said Lachlan, "and am very grateful for support from the CHMC NSW in helping me to restore my Jeep.....the generous Grant will greatly assist me in acquiring the parts.....I'm excited to continue progressing with my project and to contribute to the preservation of historic vehicles."

The grant is part of the CHMC's Youth Awards initiative to assist young enthusiasts to fulfill their ambitions in projects involving either restoration, preservation, research or photography of historic vehicles, and to acknowledge their efforts in those areas.

"We are thrilled to support Lachlan." said Jim Hatton, President of the CHMC. "His dedication to historic vehicles exemplifies the kind of future for the movement that we aim to foster through this program."

<u>TfNSW/Registration Liaison Officer Report</u> – (Peter Wright) Over the past year he represented CHMC at 4 meetings of the Historic and Classic Industry Working group, 4 meetings of the Vehicle Standards working group and 2 updates on Country Road Safety.

The HVS Options, Accessories and Safety Items list - Some key points:

• Emphasis is on authenticity not originality

• It is mandatory for clubs not to approve a vehicle on HVS that requires a VSAAS Compliance Certificate as outlined in VSI 6

• Even though modifications not requiring VSCCS Certification do not exclude vehicles from HVS, clubs are still able to hold vehicles they approve for HVS to a higher standard of authenticity.

From my observations of vehicles on HVS and questions received the following items appear to be misunderstood (VSI 6 reference in front of each):

• 15/16 – wheel and tyre size (width cannot be greater than 1"; diameter increased by 7%). Later vehicles have a tyre placard; if does not exist Club Scrutineers should seek evidence of authentic wheel & tyre size from registered operator.

- 17/18 hydraulic and disc brake conversions
- 39 after market seats or swapping bench to bucket seats
- 9 Fitting manual floor change that modifies transmission tunnel.

VSI 6 does cover motorcycles – additional items 54 to 58 are specifically for them.

CVS Applications – some clubs allow vehicles with modification. CHMC offers these clubs access to the Classic Vehicle Scheme as an Approved Organisation. Classic Vehicle Number plates – reddish lettering with "F" suffix, e.g.00134F

Registrars Report. (Alan Early)

The 93 clubs in CHMC represents 7 927 members with a total of 11 589 vehicles comprising 8 897 on HVS, 99 on CVS, 444 On full rego, 2 239 unregistered. Of HVS vehicles 76 % are cars/utes, 21% motorcycles, 1.9 % trucks, 0.3% tractors. 2/3 of vehicles comprise 1960's or later. 3% are veteran, 8% vintage and 11% post veteran.




