

This venue was on the property now known a SPRINGS GARDEN WORLD. Not a lot of the old Willow Springs is left apart from the pool.

I can remember the club putting on a free barbeque and having ice creams for the kids. After a while, we did something different either based at the old clubhouse in Water St or at another venue. I can remember a meal at the Shamrock Hotel. These events may have involved a bit of a run beforehand..

On moving to Rocla Court in 1993, we tended to have our Christmas function at the club house particularly after the big room was completed in 2000. We often used a caterer to try to make it a day where the Ladies didn't have to spend time with preparation and cleaning up. During those times our ladies were very prominent in club organisation.

After a time, we found it was easier and often cheaper using another venue as they did everything and all we had to do was turn up. We continued to have a car event on the same day and the dinner has always been subsidized as far as I can recollect.
